A comprehensive procurement process was followed, whereby bids were evaluated through three main stages: a pre-qualification questionnaire (PQQ), invitations to participate in dialogue (ITP) and a competitive dialogue phase.	
14:05	Case study Health North Norway Bjørn Nilsen, Helse Nord RHF Procurement of a joint EHR system for the Northern Health region to be used by all hospitals in the region not only to maintain documentation required by clinicians, but also to support clinical processes. The EHR is part of a wider cultural and organisational change in healthcare delivery. The procurement was widely publicised , applications assessed and candidates selected. An evaluation and negotiation phase ensued and the project group's recommendations were presented to the steering committee.


